Today, Palmer River Gold is rarer than Diamonds, but in the 1800's prospectors could collect nuggets as big as 13 ounces by turning over a rock in this thriving goldfield.

For those inflicted with Gold Fever, you can still be rewarded with nuggets between a few grams and up to 3 ounces. Heavier nuggets are so rare that those weighing more than one ounce are valued at twice the price! Gold Nuggets are collector's specimens and valued considerably higher than the gold price, a nugget should never be melted down.



The Palmer River Goldfields are situated south of Laura and North of Chillagoe in outback North Queensland and have captured the hearts of many local prospectors.



Many legends and folklore surround the Palmer River turbulent and violent history including massacres and murders. This area continues to be a volatile region with a prospector being murdered as recent as 2014.
